Residents of Knox and surrounding counties are invited to participate in the UT/TSU Knox County Master Gardener Volunteer Training in 2019. The training dates will be held at the UT campus on the following Tuesday evenings from 5:30-8:30: **January 15, 22, 29, February 5, 12, 19, 26, March 5, 12, 19, 26, April 2, 9, 16.**

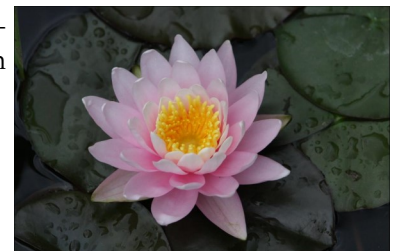
Topics include **Basic Botany, Plant Disease Management, Soils, Fruit and Berry Gardening, Organic Gardening and more.** Knox county participants will return 40 hours of volunteer service to Knox county following the training. Out-of-county students will be asked to return 20 hours of service to Knox county and 20 hours to their home county in exchange for the 40 hours of training. The cost of the course is **\$125 if paid on or before the early registration deadline of November 1st** or **\$150 if paid by November 15th.** The registration fee includes all training materials and is due *after* your application has been approved.
